

CLUB DRESS CODE

### Dress Code Policy

In order for members and their guests to properly prepare for any program or event we have prepared a booklet of appropriate attire. All members and their guests are asked to dress appropriately and adhere to all dress code policies. You are always encouraged to advocate for your Club by wearing DCC branded attire when appropriate.

Attire must meet the standards outlined in this booklet. Staff may at any time reserve the right, in their sole discretion, to deny access to any facility if a member or their guests' attire does not align with Club standards.

Unless otherwise noted, Club Casual dress is the preferred attire for most Club areas and events.

#### Attire Should:

Respect the values and traditions of our Club with regard to appropriate and tasteful dress.

Be considerate of other members and guests; members are encouraged to consider respect for tradition, modesty, and comfort level of fellow members when making attire selections. If in doubt as to whether or not attire complies with these guidelines, please choose a more conservative option.

Attire Not Acceptable Anywhere At The Club:

Gentlemen wearing hats indoors. Hat bills must face forwards when worn outdoors.

Overly revealing clothing.

Clothing with graphics or inappropriate language.

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# Dining



### LADIES DINING

Poolside is the only location swim wear is permitted.

Caps are not permitted in any social or dining areas of the Clubhouse.

Social events and all dining including outside terraces basic standard of dress is dressy casual. Pants suits, skirts and dresses must be to the knee, blouses, and coordinated separates. Sports wear can be worn in all main dining rooms and terraces.



### GENTLEMEN DINING

Poolside is the only location swim wear is permitted.

Caps are not allowed in any social or dining areas of the Clubhouse.

Dress trousers, dress shirt or turtleneck, coats recommended. For traditional Club events Easter, Mother's Day, Thanksgiving & Holiday Brunches, coats are required for gentlemen 12 and older .





# Golf





### ALL PLAYERS

The following Dress Code applies to the golf course and all practice facilities.

Must wear spike-less, soft-spike, or rubber-soled shoes. No one is allowed on the golf course or the practice facilities barefooted or with sandals or flip flops. Denim, baggy cargo pants or baggy cargo shorts, running or tennis shorts

ARE NOT PERMITTED. Caps must be worn with brim forward at all times.

### GENTLEMEN

Must wear appropriate golf shirts (TUCKED IN). Golf trousers or Bermuda length shorts.



## LADIES

The following Dress Code applies to the golf course and all practice facilities.

Sleeveless blouses are permitted.

Bermuda length shorts and skirts, and golf slacks or culottes.

Leggings may be worn under a skirt or skort.





# RACQUETS





Only non-marking shoes may be worn on the racquet sports courts. Black-soled running shoes are not allowed. Caps must be worn with the brim facing forward.

All white attire is encouraged but not required, unless playing tennis on the grass courts.

### PLATFORM TENNIS

Athletic attire is appropriate for platform tennis. In the winter months, it is best to dress in layers.

### LADIES TENNIS

Appropriate length shorts, tennis dresses or outfits.



Only non-marking shoes may be worn on the racquet sports courts. Black-soled running shoes are not allowed. Caps must be worn with the brim facing forward.

All white attire is encouraged but not required, unless playing tennis on the grass courts.

### GENTLEMEN TENNIS

Tennis shirts with collars and tennis shorts or trousers.





# FITNESS



### FITNESS CENTER

Appropriate dress is required for use of the facility, including T-shirts, sweatshirts, shorts or athletic trousers, other garments designed for exercise activities, and athletic shoes with non-marking soles. Caps must be worn with brim forward at all times.

#### Pool

#### Swimmers must wear proper attire in the pool area at all times.

Cutoffs or shorts not specifically designed for swimming are not permitted in the pool. Denim is not permitted. To enhance the experience of all our members and guests, we ask that you maintain a family-friendly image by wearing appropriate swim wear that's in good taste. Ladies are required to wear modest swim suits and gentlemen are to wear swim trunks or triathlon shorts during recreational swim; speedos are acceptable for lap swimming and fitness swimming only.

Untrained children must wear two articles of protective swim wear. A disposable swim diaper is to be worn on the inside with an outer reusable swim diaper fitted over anytime they are in the pool. If they are in the main pool, they need to be under the direct supervision of a responsible adult that is in the water with the child at all times.





# CROQUET & LAWN BOWLING



Suitable white attire is recommended as per tradition but not required. Only tennis or similar flat-soled shoes are permissible on the court.

# SKATING & HOCKEY

Denim is permitted at the Skatehouse ONLY during skating season. The wearing of baggy style cargo pants or shorts, & t-shirts are not permitted at any time.





# Juniors



## RACQUETS

Encouraged to wear collared shirts or acceptable athletic shirts. They may not wear swim wear, short shorts, denim or similar unsuitable attire.



### Golf

Boys: Must wear appropriate golf shirts (tucked in). Golf trousers or Bermuda length shorts.

Girls: Sleeveless blouses are permitted. Bermuda length shorts and skirts, and golf slacks or culottes.



### FITNESS

Appropriate dress is required for use of the facility, including T-shirts, sweatshirts, shorts or athletic trousers, other garments designed for exercise activities, and athletic shoes with non-marking soles. Caps must be worn with brim forward at all times.



## DINING & SOCIAL

For traditional Club events Easter, Mother's Day, Thanksgiving & Holiday Brunches, coats are required for gentlemen 12 and older.


